

10th Annual Amis du cap Tourmente Photo Contest

2008 Contest Rules

1. Eligibility

The photo contest is organized by *Association des amis et amies du cap Tourmente* (ACCT) in order to promote photography as a hobby and the Cap Tourmente National Wildlife Area. The contest is open to all amateur photographers who are or are not members of the Association. Professional photographers and jury members are not eligible to participate in the Contest.

2. Contest Categories

- Terrestrial Fauna
- Presence of Humans
- Flora
- Birds
- Landscape
- History

3. General Information

Entrants must indicate on their entry form the category in which they want to enter their photographs; The same photograph may not be entered in two (2) categories; The entrant must be the sole copyright holder of each photograph submitted.

IMPORTANT! Only photographs taken in the Cap Tourmente National Wildlife Area and in compliance with the Contest Rules are eligible.

4. Technical Requirements

Only photographs and slides shall be accepted. Digital photos must be printed. The entrant's name and category must be written on the back of the photo or on the slide frame; Entrants may also indicate technical parameters, such as: type of camera, type of film, speed, aperture, etc. ; In the case of slides, entrants must also write "L" and "R" on the frame to indicate the left and right sides of the slide.

5. Entry Form

Each photo must be accompanied by a fully completed entry form.

6. Entry Limit

Entrants may enter a maximum of two (2) photographs per category (limit of 12 photos per entrant); The same photograph may not be entered in two (2) different categories.

7. How to Enter

Photographs entered in this contest must be mailed to the following address: Association des amis du cap Tourmente, 570, chemin du Cap-Tourmente, St-Joachim, Qc G0A 3X0; or delivered by hand at the Amis Souvenir Shop, Léon-Provancher Pavilion, Cap Tourmente National Wildlife Area.

8. Entry Deadline

Entrants must mail their photographs by October 26, 2008 (postmarked by the deadline date) to the above-mentioned address.

9. Jury

Submitted photographs shall be evaluated by a jury consisting of three (3) members selected by the Board of Directors of the *Association des ami(e)s du cap Tourmente*; The jury's decision shall be final and binding; Photographs shall be evaluated based on their technical and visual quality, as well as on the interpretation of the subject. Priority shall be given to clear photos, as opposed to dark photos that do not print well . The jury reserves the right to request a negative, if necessary, in order to authenticate the photo.

10. Publication of Contest Results

Winning photographs and the photographer's name shall be revealed in the weeks following the closing of the contest. The names and photos shall be published in a later issue of the *L'écho du cap* newspaper.

11. Certification of Copyright

Each entrant certifies that he or she is the photographer and the sole copyright holder of the photograph(s) submitted.

12. Limitation of Liability

Photographs and slides shall be handled with the utmost care. However, the AACT, organizing committee and jury members accept no liability for damaged, lost or late entries.

13. Licence for Reproduction, Publication and Exhibition

Each contest entrant grants the *Association des amis et amies du cap Tourmente* a licence to reproduce, publish and exhibit photographs. This licence applies to any project to promote the Association and the Cap Tourmente National Wildlife Area. The entrant shall make no copyright claim against the Association.

14. Prizes

At the close of the contest, six (6) prizes shall be awarded, one per category;
Prizes are a \$50 gift certificate that can be exchanged at the Léon-Provancher Souvenir Shop;
The photographers of winning photographs undertake to accept prizes as awarded. Prizes cannot be redeemed for cash;
All prizes shall be mailed.

15. Law

Any litigation respecting the conduct of the contest or the awarding of a prize may be submitted to the Board of Directors of the *Association des amis et amies du cap Tourmente*.

16. Caution

Any communication directly or indirectly related to this contest with a jury member, prior to the photo evaluation period, may result in disqualification.

17. Compliance with Contest Rules

Each entrant confirms that he or she has read and understood the Contest Rules and that he or she agrees to be bound by the Contest Rules.
